## **GUIDELINES & PROCEDURES**

- 1. The Board approves the Superintendent's membership in:
  - a) Canadian Association of School System Administrators;
  - b) The Canadian Education Association;
  - c) The College of Alberta School Superintendents;
  - d) Canadian Association for Practical Study of Law in Education;
  - e) Rotary; and
  - f) Other such organizations approved by the Board through Board resolution.
- 2. The Board approves of the Superintendent's attendance at the following:
  - a) The Canadian Association of Principals convention (ULead);
  - b) The Alberta School Board Association convention and zone meetings;
  - c) The Public School Boards' Association of Alberta convention, meetings and related professional development;
  - d) Meetings and conventions of the College of Alberta School Superintendents;
  - e) Provincial or Peace District meetings set up by the Department of Education, ASBA, ATA, universities, and Zone or Area 1, when related to responsibilities.
- 3. Attendance at any additional conferences will be as per conditions of contract.
