

# **POLICY HGAC – Religious Education**

The Board supports Religious Education as a program of choice in those communities where the school council requests it and with the prior approval of the Superintendent or designate.

## **PURPOSE**

To allow the opportunity for religious instruction.

### **GUIDELINES & PROCEDURES**

- 1. The emphasis of the religious program is on those aspects upon which there is broad agreement, rather than upon denominational points of view.
- 2. Schools respect the wishes of parents about their child's participation in religious education by requiring written consent.
- 3. A Religious Education Committee, consisting of the Superintendent or designate, the Principal, a teacher and School Council representative from each school offering the program, shall meet as needed to discuss program related matters. The Committee may include a representative from the local ministerial association.
- 4. This Committee will report to the Board, through the Superintendent or designate, providing a copy of the curriculum.
- 5. A teacher shall be present during all instruction.
- 6. The instruction time is determined by the principal in consultation with the teacher, to a maximum of 500 minutes per year.
- 7. Each instructor may respond to denominational questions that arise. In addition to presenting his/her denominational viewpoint, he/she should suggest that the concerned class members consult their own clergy on the matter.
