

POLICY HIAD – Resources for Schools

The Board acknowledges that materials provided by parents and special interest groups may serve as useful resources in schools.

PURPOSE:

To provide guidelines for management of materials that parents/groups want used in schools.

DEFINITIONS

Special Interest Groups: a group of people acting together in support of a common interest

GUIDELINES & PROCEDURES

- 1. Parents or special interest groups wishing to provide resource materials shall submit a written request to the School Administrator detailing the reason for the request and submitting copies of the proposed materials.
- 2. In the event that a parent or special interest group wishes to appeal the School Administrator's decision, the group shall submit copies of the proposed material to the Superintendent.
- 3. In the event that a parent or special interest group wishes to appeal the Superintendent's decision, the group shall submit a request for appeal and copies of the proposed material to the Board of Trustees.
