

POLICY IECB – Foreign Students – Admission to Schools

Provided there are sufficient facilities and that tuition fees are paid, the admission of foreign students is beneficial to education.

PURPOSE:

To accommodate the admission of foreign students to Peace Wapiti School Division.

GUIDELINES & PROCEDURES

- 1. Foreign students are those who are not landed immigrants or whose parents or legal guardians are not landed immigrants in Canada.
- 2. The Board delegates to the Superintendent the authority to deal with applications from foreign students requesting admission into schools:
 - a) All applications must be submitted to the Superintendent.
 - b) All correspondence pertaining to admission of foreign students must be handled through the Superintendent's office.
 - c) Foreign students, other than those on student exchanges, will not be registered unless the appropriate documents are presented.
- 3. A non-refundable administrative fee of \$250 will be required to commence the application process.
- 4. The Board shall assess to foreign students, a tuition fee equal to an average student cost.
- 5. The Board may also assess, to foreign students, any other education costs that may be incurred while attending its schools.
- 6. Foreign students on Rotary, Lions or similar exchange programs may have their fees waived on approval of the Superintendent.
