

POLICY IFCJ–Student Violence, Use of Weapons & Criminal Offences

The possession and use of weapons on school property, school buses and school related field trips is prohibited.

PURPOSE:

To support the development and maintenance of a safe and secure learning environment for students and staff.

DEFINITIONS

- 1. Violence in this policy shall mean any verbal or physical action taken which threatens or results in the inflicting of physical, emotional, or psychological distress or bodily harm.
- 2. A weapon is any object which is used or intended for use to threaten, intimidate or inflict injury or harm on another or self.
- 3. For the purposes of this policy 'school' refers to the school, on school grounds, or buses, or school-related or school-sanctioned activities.

GUIDELINES & PROCEDURES

- 1. All persons, with the exceptions of law enforcement officers, are prohibited from bringing weapons into schools, on to school grounds, or buses or school related activities.
- 2. Principals may permit otherwise prohibited objects to be brought to school for use in approved instructional programs.
